Under 15 All-Rounder Competition

The teams of 7 boys and 7 girls may have three competitors in each event.

The athletes compete in either a 2 or 4 Lap Race on the track, in one of the jumping events (Standing Long Jump, Standing Triple Jump or Vertical Jump) and in either Speed Bounce or Shot. They may also run in either the Relay or Paarlauf.
